BUS TRIP INFORMATION

Planning for a great bus trip is well underway. The first stop on the trip will be at the beautiful Olbrich Gardens (olbrich.org) in Madison where, incidentally, the Wisconsin Daylily Society is having its annual daylily plant sale.

From there we will go to the UW Arboretum to view their garden displays and take time to eat the **bag lunch each person should bring**. Soda and water will be provided on the bus along with various snacks. After lunch, we will travel to Stoughton to visit the fabulous Flower Factory which features the Midwest's largest selection of perennials, hostas and ornamental grasses (theflowerfactorynursery.com).

The date is **August 14th**, the second Saturday. There will be **four** pick up locations, the first at State Fair Park and Ride lot located just west of 76th Street and just south of I-94 where you can board the bus from 7:00 to 7:30 A.M. The next stop will be at the I-43/894-Hwy 100 Park and Ride at 7:45; then on to Goerkes Corners Park and Ride in Waukesha at 8 AM and finally to the Hwy 83 Park and Ride in Delafield, north of I-94 one light and just west of 83 about 8:15. **Plan to indicate which stop you will be using.**

The cost is **\$20 per person** which includes the admission fee at Olbrich.
